RULES

- 1 - All normal Short Mat rules will apply other than those shown below. Normal rules are on the Short Mat board.
- 2 - Each player will use 4 woods only.
- 3 - Games will be of 7 ends only.
- 4 - If games are tied an extra end will be played, with a toss to determine who wins the jack and decision to bowl first or not (one single toss decides both).
- 5 - It would be beneficial if the players could organise a 'marker', to help with measuring, give guidance on shot woods, decide whether woods are 'dead', etc.
- 6 - The first player listed in the Challenger and should offer two dates / times to play to their opponent. Please try to be flexible on dates/times.
- 7 - Matches will be played Wednesday evening (on the proviso that the Clubhouse can be locked after games), or on other days to be advised to all players via email.
- 8 - Players are 'handicapped' between 0 and 6. The difference in handicap is then added to highest handicapped players score.
So if a player with a handicap of 6 plays a player with a handicap of 0, the player with '6' starts on a score of 6, whilst their opponent starts on 0.
So if a player with a handicap of 4 plays a player with a handicap of 2, the player with '4' starts on a score of 2, (4 minus 2) whilst their opponent starts on 0.
And if two players both with handicaps of 4 play each other, both players start with a score of 0 (4 minus 4 for each).
- 9 - There is no 'play by' date, but please try to play all your games asap. We would hope to end this mid-February (hopefully). I may need to chase you if you don't play quickly!!!
- 10 - If either player wants 'trial ends' feel free. You can decide yourselves. No more than two trial ends though please!
