MENS CHAMPIONSHIP

First to 21

4 Woods Each

2 WOOD CHAMPIONSHIP

21 Ends

2 Woods Each

VETERANS CHAMPIONSHIP

18 Ends

3 Woods Each

½ Handicap applies to over 80's bowlers

i.e. handicaps of 8 & 6 the difference is 2 (half 1)

VICTORIA HANDICAP

First to 21

4 Woods Each

Difference of handicap to be added to 21

i.e. Handicaps of 9 & 3 the difference is 6

Higher handicap will have to get to 27

FIXED JACK HANDICAP PAIRS

21 Ends

2 Woods Each

Start with Long Jack followed by:

2 Short Ends

2 Long Ends and repeated

DINKENOR TRIPLES

18 Ends

3 Woods Each

4321 CHAMPIONSHIP

First to 106

4 Woods Each

JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIP

First to 21

4 Woods Each

MENS PAIRS

18 Ends

4 Woods Each

First to 21

Each Set consists of 7 Ends

2 Woods Each

HANDICAP PAIRS

18 Ends

3 Woods Each

NOTE - All matches must be played by the end of day and date shown for each round.

NOTE - The 'Challenger' (first drawn) must arrange a marker for all singles matches and give 3 dates to the opponent with one being a weekend, and within 14 days of the next round commencing.

NOTE - The 'Challenger' (first drawn) will have a choice of rink (subject to RINK PRIORITIES for games being played at the same time).

NOTE - If a player is not available during a round ONE substitute may be used as long as they have not already played in that particular competition. The original player may play in the next round if then available.

NOTE - You MUST be available to play in the finals on all three days Friday 2nd September, Saturday 3rd September and Sunday 4th September. If you are not available PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE COMPETITIONS.
